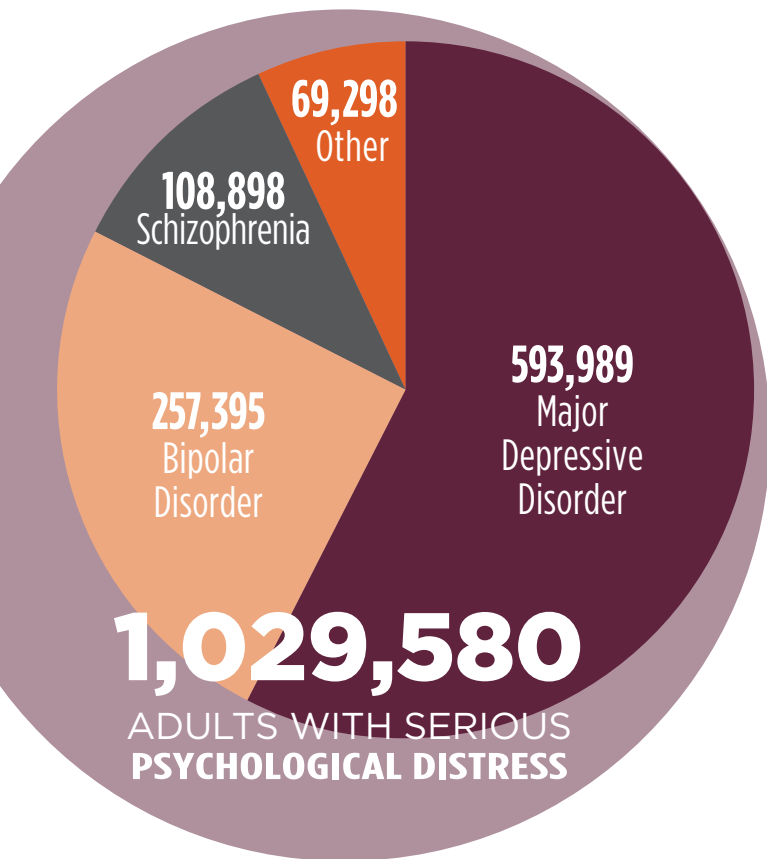


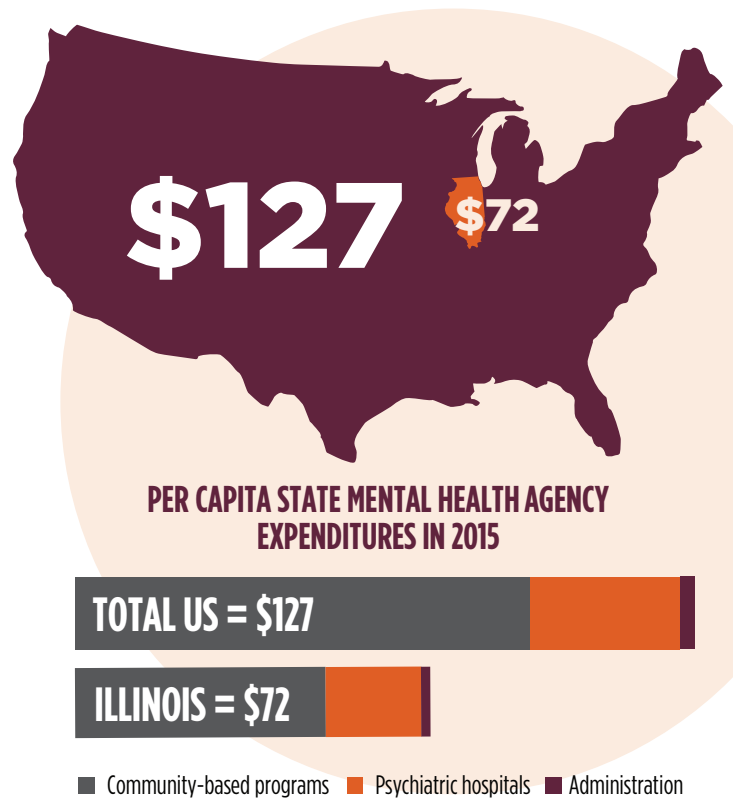
# The Cost of Not Treating Mental Illness to Illinois

Illinois legislators need to pass a budget that can comprehensively fund services that include mental health and substance abuse **now**

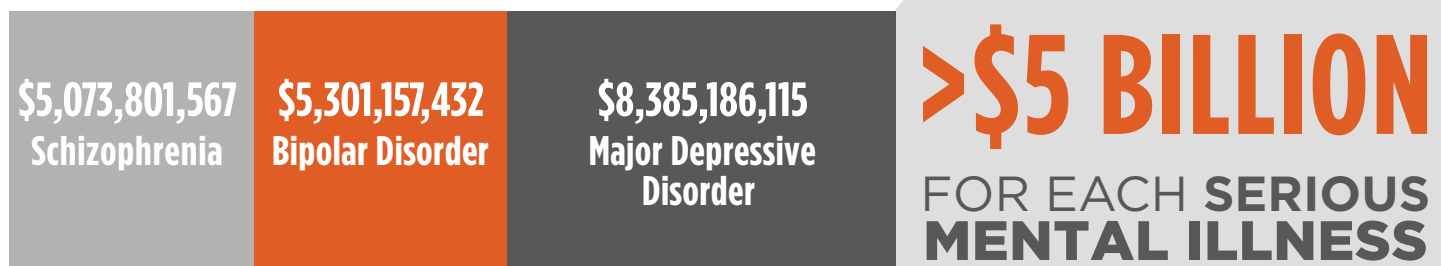
## Estimated Number of Adults Living with Mental Illness in 2015<sup>1</sup>
